Driving Directions

From RDU Airport, Raleigh and Points East

- Take I-40 West to Exit 279B–Durham Freeway (NC 147 North)
- Take Durham Freeway to Exit 14–Swift Avenue
- Turn left onto Swift Avenue
- Turn right onto Campus Drive
- Undergraduate Admissions will be 0.5 miles on the right

From Greensboro and Points West

- Take I-85 North to Exit 172–Durham Freeway (NC 147 South)
- Take Durham Freeway to Exit 14–Swift Avenue
- Turn right onto Swift Avenue
- Turn right onto Campus Drive
- Undergraduate Admissions will be 0.5 miles on the right

From Chapel Hill

- Take 15-501 Bypasses North to Exit 107-NC 751 (towards Duke University West Campus)
- Turn right onto NC 751
- Follow Cameron Blvd
- Turn left onto Duke University Road
- Turn left onto Chapel Drive
- Take 1st right onto Campus Drive
- Undergraduate Admissions will be on the left

Parking

A small number of parking spaces are available in front of our office on a first-come, first-served basis (passes are available in our office). A parking pass is not needed for Saturday and Sunday.

An additional 23 spaces are located behind our building, which can be accessed at 2122 Campus Drive. If these spaces are full, please park in either the Sarah P. Duke Gardens parking lot (Option #3) or the Nasher Museum of Art parking lot (Option #4). The Duke Gardens lot is a 3-5 minute walk to Undergraduate Admissions while the Nasher Museum lot is a 7-10 minute walk.

After parking, please check in at McClendon Commons, our visitors center located immediately behind the Office of Undergraduate Admissions.

PARKING DIRECTIONS

Please obtain a parking pass from visitor reception before parking. **You must display a parking pass on your dashboard for Parking Option #1 and #2 or you will be ticketed.** A parking pass is not needed on Saturday and Sunday.

Parking Option #1 (Parking Pass Needed)

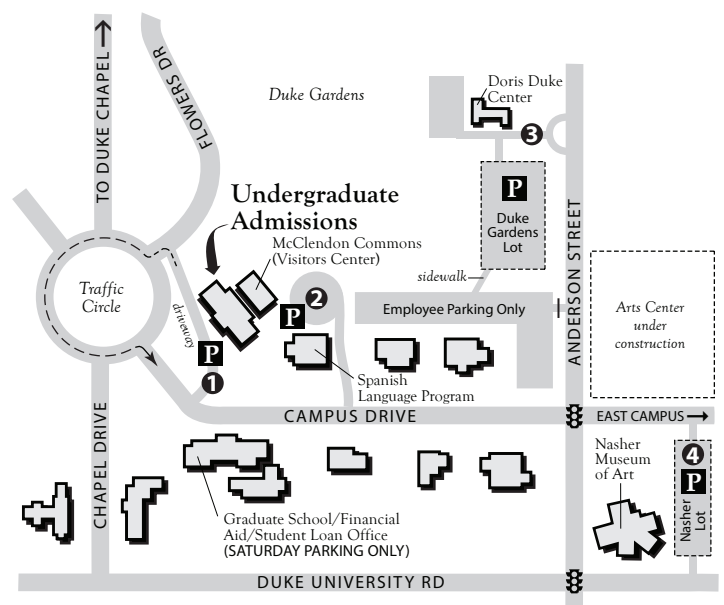
If there are spaces available, you may park in the driveway in front of Undergraduate Admissions in the spaces marked "Visitor Parking." *If no spaces are available:*

Parking Option #2 (Parking Pass Needed)

- Proceed to the end of the driveway
- Turn left onto **Flowers Drive**, then turn right onto the **traffic circle**
- Follow the circle and turn right onto **Campus Drive**
- Turn left at the driveway beside **Spanish Language Program**
- Park in the circle lot behind the Spanish Language Program house

Overflow Parking Option #3

- Proceed to the end of the driveway
- Turn left onto **Flowers Drive**, then turn right onto the **traffic circle**
- Follow the circle and turn right onto **Campus Drive**
- At the intersection of **Anderson Street** and **Campus Drive**, turn left
- Proceed 300 yards and turn left into the **Sarah P. Duke Gardens**
- The parking lot will be on left (*Parking is \$2.00 per hour*)
- To return to Undergraduate Admissions, follow the sidewalk at the far end of the lot as shown on the map



Overflow Parking Option #4

- Proceed to the end of the driveway
- Turn left onto **Flowers Drive**, then turn right onto the **traffic circle**
- Follow the circle and turn right onto **Campus Drive**
- Proceed straight at the intersection of **Anderson Street** and **Campus Drive** and then turn right and park in the **Nasher Museum of Art** lot (*Parking is \$2.00 per hour*)
- To return to Undergraduate Admissions, follow the sidewalk along **Campus Drive**
