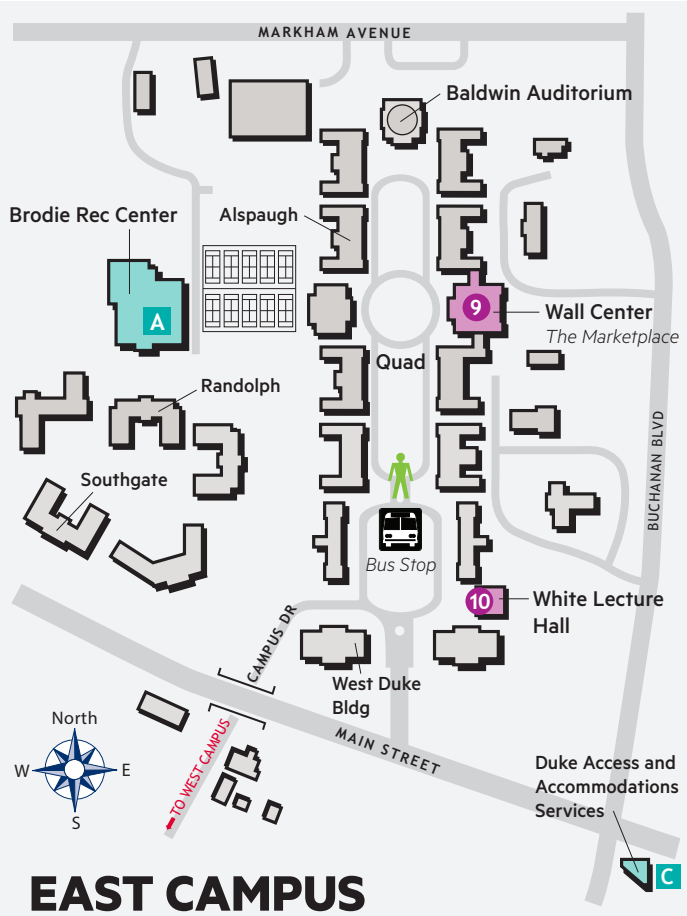

The t-shirt is the product of some of the many different linguistic communities here at Duke. On the shirt, “Duke” is written phonetically in 14 different languages. The alphabets on the t-shirt are: American Sign Language, Arabic, Binary Code, Braille, Cherokee, Cyrillic, Hebrew, Japanese, Korean, Mandarin, Morse Code, Roman (English), Sanskrit, and Tamil.
